A Message from your Regional Manager

We wrapped up the final in-person Regional Officer Connection training session a couple of weeks ago. I'm happy to report that it was an extremely productive and engaging opportunity to connect face to face with hundreds of H.O.G. Officers from around the country to share experiences, new ideas and best practices for running H.O.G. Chapters. I came away from the sessions truly impressed and grateful for the passion and enthusiasm officers like you have for the Harley Owners Group and your tireless commitment to serve our members. Thank you!

We covered a wide variety of topics in the ROC sessions, with robust discussions about things that are working great as well as some areas of opportunity. One recurring theme is that there is still a degree of confusion surrounding the RIDE 365 programs, specifically about how member miles are recorded and tracked in the Annual and Chapter Mileage Challenges. Briefly, the key to these programs is the mileage reading. Mileage readings

must be officially recorded by a Harley-Davidson dealership and entered into the H.O.G. Management Tool to start and stop the clock each calendar year. Ideally these readings should occur January 1 and December 31 to capture the full year's mileage, but they can happen any time during the year as long as there are at least two. If you have any questions about how this works, please visit the RIDE 365 program page or reach out to me directly. We recently announced an exciting new rewards program linked to RIDE 365 (see below) so this program should see increased participation by members this year.

Knowing that many officers were not able to attend an in-person ROC session this season, we will be offering some additional virtual sessions in the coming weeks for those who would still like get together to cover the key topics and material. Keep an eye out for an email from me soon with a few meeting dates.

In the meantime, we're entering a very busy part of the riding season, with H.O.G. Rallies, Check-Ins and other events coming fast and furious over the next few months. I'll be rolling up quite a few miles myself and expect you will be too. Hope to see you on the road soon!


