The Mid America H.O.G. Rally will be held in St. Charles Missouri. This is a first ever Regional H.O.G. Rally in the state of Missouri. This event starts on June 22 and runs thru June 24. The Mid America H.O.G. rally will provide three fun filled days of great rides along two of our nations mightiest river's; the Mississippi and the Missouri rivers. This rally will be held where Lewis and Clark began their epic journey over two centuries ago.

The Mid America H.O.G. rally committee is planning nightly events consisting of an early bird welcome party at St. Charles Harley-Davidson on Thursday night, a bike night, a street party in historic downtown St. Charles, and a party in the park to close out the rally. Live music every night as well as a day at St. Charles Harley-Davidson. If that's not enough for you, their going to have Police motorcycle equestrian demos, H.D. demo truck, Biker Bingo, L.O.H. ride to acknowledge all lady riders and passengers. A guided ride to the world-famous St. Louis Arch, 15 rides which will be both guided and self-guided.

The next rally I want to inform you about is closer to home and will be a very good ride. The Nine Passes H.O.G. There are 50 passes in the Sierra Nevada mountains and this ride will be taking you over Nine of the best passes in the area. This Rally has a great mix of twisted turns, wide open flats and mountain roads. During these rides you will take in breath taken views the whole time through the agriculture heartland of California at 60 foot above sea level to 9,600 feet on the Sonora pass. You will also experience piney forests, mountain passes, mountain lakes and streams and the desert floor up close. This Rally will fill up fast, don't miss out, register soon. 
















A Message from your Regional Manager
